



Concept for the sensitization-seminar in the project BUILD UP Skills QUALITRAIN

Executive Summary

Starting point

Within the project BUILD UP Skills QUALITRAIN, a national training plan for construction workers in Germany is translated into concrete actions. This roadmap is intended to contribute to reach the energy and climate policy objectives in buildings by way of ensuring necessary qualifications and an adequate quantity of construction workers. One part of the project is the sensitization of construction workers by trainers. For this multiplying purpose, a seminar concept was developed and tested, which can be used by other chambers of crafts and craft training centers.

Main objectives, content and added value of the seminar

Main objective of this seminar is to sensitize trainers and teachers for interfaces between craft trades and for the understanding of houses as systems in context of energetic construction and renovation processes. Therefore, the key contents are possible ways of addressing and communicating these aspects in day-to-day operational and training practice. Of particular value to participants of the seminar are the exchange of experiences, networking with other actors and the joint development of solutions.

Target groups of the Seminar

The seminar is designed to a maximum of 25 participants from the following groups

- educators / trainers in craft enterprises and training centers, particularly in construction, building and plant engineering trades and in construction industry enterprises
- teachers at vocational schools and colleges,
- lecturers and managers in training industries, which are in direct contact with construction site workers
- architects and engineers

Duration and organization of the seminar

The seminar period is assumed to be one day (7 clock hours incl. breaks). By way of interactive working methods, participants will be able to deal with different interdisciplinary questions in a short time – and simultaneously, they have the opportunity to exchange experiences. In addition to the seminar, the participants can use an online learning module which contains complementary information.

Components of the seminar concept

The seminar concept contains all the relevant information necessary for the preparation (letter of invitation, agenda, proposal for trades distributor), execution (curriculum/methodological advice, presentation) and follow-up (feedback form, additional information) of the seminar. These suggestions can be customized to regional and professional conditions.

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
